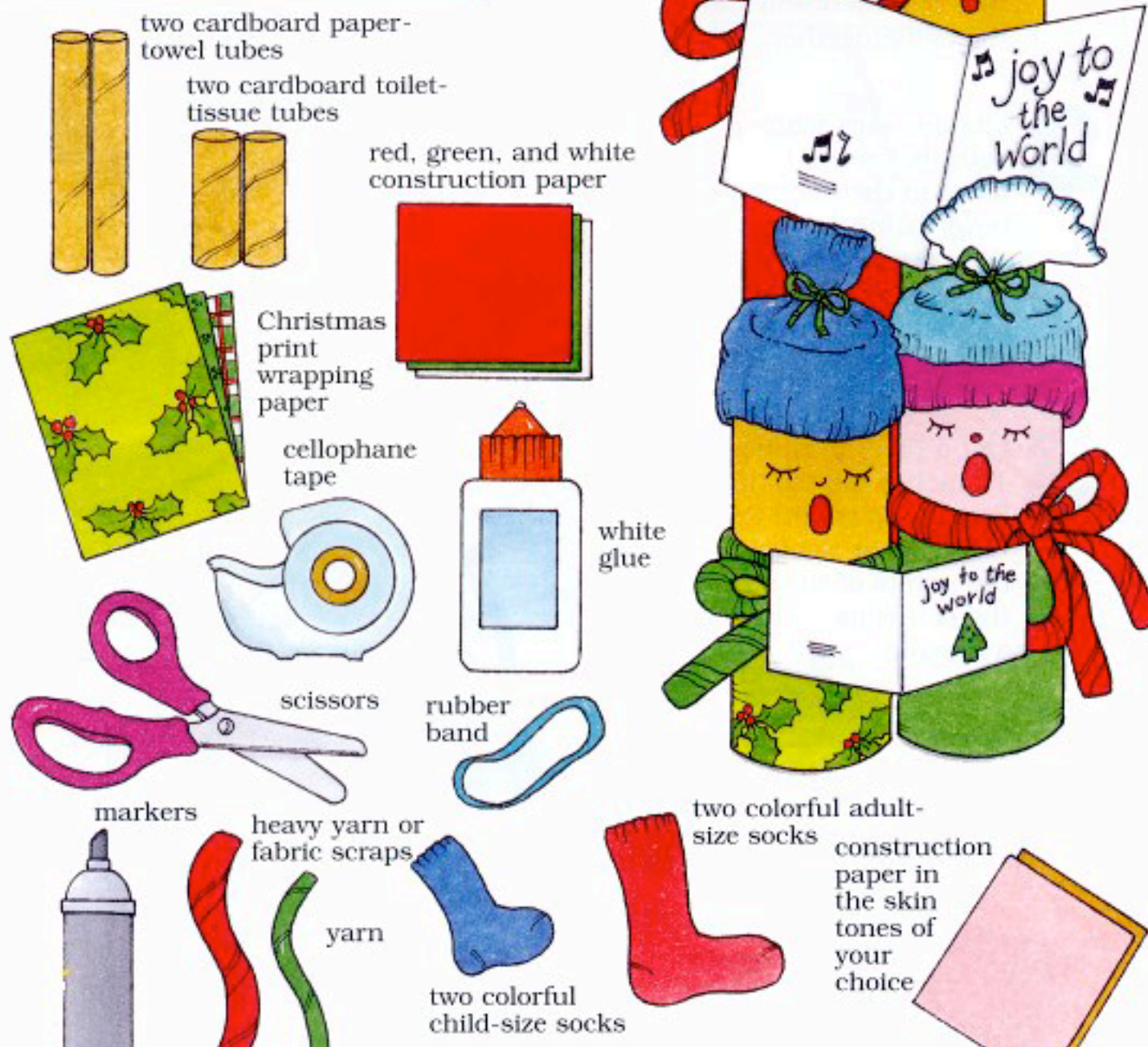


Christmas Carolers

The cluster of carolers makes a charming Christmas decoration.

What you need:



What you do:

- 1** Cut one of the two long tubes so that it is an inch or two shorter than the other tube.
- 2** Cover all four tubes with a different paper, using the wrapping paper and the red and green construction paper. Glue the paper around each tube and hold it in place with cellophane tape.
- 3** Wrap the top part of each tube with a strip of skin-colored construction paper, gluing it, then securing it with tape.
- 4** Cut the cuff off each of the four socks to make hats for the carolers. Tie the open end of each cuff closed with a piece of colorful yarn tied in a bow. Glue the cuff hats from the adult socks on the tall tube carolers and the cuff hats from the children's socks on the short tube carolers.
- 5** Use the markers to draw a face on each caroler.
- 6** Tie a piece of heavy yarn or a fabric scrap around the neck of each caroler for a scarf.
- 7** Glue the two tall carolers together side by side. Glue the two short carolers together side by side and in front of the tall carolers. Use a rubber band to hold the carolers together until the glue dries.
- 8** Cut a music book for each pair of carolers from the white paper. Decorate each book by using the markers. Glue a book in front of each pair of carolers.
