

Reindeer Treat Box

*This reindeer is the perfect container
for storing or delivering a batch of Christmas cookies.*

What you need:



What you do:

1 Cover the outside of the box and the lid with strips of masking tape to create a better gluing surface. Cover the box and the lid with brown construction paper.

2 Cut two ears from the brown paper and glue them to the sides of the box.

3 Make eyes from the black and white paper. Glue the eyes to the box just below the ears.

4 Glue the red pom-pom to the box below the eyes for a nose.

5 Poke a hole through each side of the box just behind the ears. Make each antler by cutting a 3-inch (8-cm) piece of pipe cleaner and wrapping it around the rest of the pipe cleaner towards one end to form the branches of the antler. Slide the end of a pipe cleaner antler into each hole and use masking tape to secure the end of the pipe cleaner inside the box.

6 Tie the red yarn or ribbon in a bow around the neck of the reindeer.

7 Trim the bottom of the box by gluing a strip of red rickrack around it.

8 Line the inside of the box with a square of red tissue and you are ready to tuck in a batch of Christmas cookies to deliver to a friend or neighbor.
